



2022 CALMS Student Scholarship

Due April 15, 2022

The California Lake Management Society (CALMS) Student Scholarship (<https://www.california-lakes.org/scholarship>) supports undergraduate and graduate students researching limnology and lake management. CALMS will award up to four \$1,250 scholarships for research conducted in summer 2022. The scholarships will be paid in two installments: \$1,000 in May 2022, and the remaining \$250 at the annual CALMS conference that will be held in the fall of 2022.

Eligible applicants must be enrolled as full-time students in an accredited California, Arizona, or Nevada college or university. A committee consisting of academic and industry representatives will judge applications. Scholarship winners will have their research plans published in the CALMS newsletter and present their research findings at the 2022 annual conference.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The application includes: (1) a resume [2 pages maximum]; (2) unofficial transcripts of recent college/university course work; (3) a summary [2300 character maximum, including spaces and punctuation] of research plans for summer 2022; and (4) two letters of recommendation from university faculty or professional mentors familiar with the student's abilities, interests, and career goals.

Application items 1-3 above should be emailed as a **single PDF** by the applicant, and letters of support sent **separately** by recommenders, to Dr. Marc Beutel, CALMS Scholarship Program Chair, at mbeutel@ucmerced.edu by Friday, April 15, 2022. Winners will be notified by Monday, May 16, 2022.
